### FIRST AID

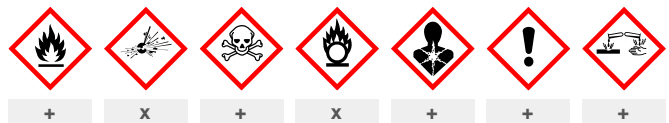
<b>Swallowed:</b>	Do NOT give milk or oil. Do NOT give alcohol.
<b>Eye:</b>	Wash with running water (minimum 15 mins). Medical attention.
<b>Skin:</b>	Wash with soap & water. Apply cleansing cream.
<b>Advice To Doctor:</b>	Emesis generally unnecessary. Debride for subcutaneous injection. Evaluate for respiratory distress. Consider lavage with cuffed tube. NO adrenalin.
<b>Fire Fighting:</b>	Keep containers cool. Keep surrounding area cool. Water spray/fog.
<b>Spills and Disposal:</b>	Eliminate ignition sources. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way.

### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE



<b>Gloves:</b>	When handling larger quantities:
<b>Respirator:</b>	Type A-P Filter of sufficient capacity. (AS/NZS 1716 & 1715, EN 143:2000 & 149:2001, ANSI Z88 or national equivalent)
<b>Storage and Transportation:</b>	Store in cool, dry, protected area. Keep out of reach of children. Keep container in a well ventilated place. Keep away from heat. Keep away from sources of ignition. No smoking.
<b>Fire/Explosion Hazard:</b>	HIGHLY FLAMMABLE. Vapours/gas heavier than air. Toxic smoke/fumes in a fire. Risk of explosion if heated under confinement. In case of fire and/or explosion, DO NOT BREATHE FUMES.
